AM Meds

2 ml Onfi (2.5 mg/ml)
5 ml Keppra (100mg/ml)
1.1 ml Vimpat (10mg/ml)

2 PM Meds

2 ml Onfi (2.5 mg/ml)

PM Meds

4 ml Onfi (2.5 mg/ml)
5 ml Keppra (100mg/ml)
1.1 ml Vimpat (10mg/ml)
10 ml Zonegran/Zonisamide (10mg/ml)
1 ml Melatonin (1mg/ml)

Harper's Rescue Med Plan and Meds

Focal Seizure- Her focal seizures can look like she is continuously looking to one side or the other. Typically you cannot get her to respond to your voice, but she may be somewhat responsive. It can also turn into cluster focal seizures. Her eyes will track or look like they are fluttering to one side or the other.

Steps:

1. Onset of focal seizure, administer nasal versed :
-Dosage: .6 mg total (.3 in each nostril)
2. After 5 minutes, give dose of Diastat rectally.
-Dosage: 7.5 mg..

***If still seizing, call 911.

When EMS arrives, administer the IM injection of Fosphenytoin (2ml)

Grand Mal Seizure: Her Grand Mal Seizures are ones that she is completely out of it. She is non responsive, eyes may be blinking rapidly, rolling back in her head, she will possibly have a bowel movement and vomit. One side of her body or both sides may be jerking in movement.

Step:

1. Onset of GMS, administer the IM injection of versed in her thigh (.5m/5mg per ml)
2. After 5 minutes, administer another IM injection of versed (.5m/5mg per ml) **and call 911**

When EMS arrives, administer the IM injection of Fosphenytoin (2ml)
